- One pupil achieved ten A passes

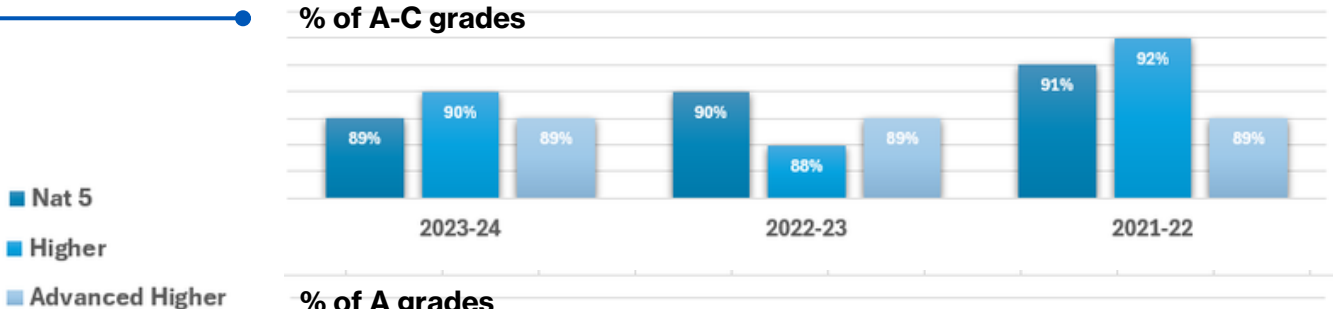

- 22 pupils achieved 4 or more A passes

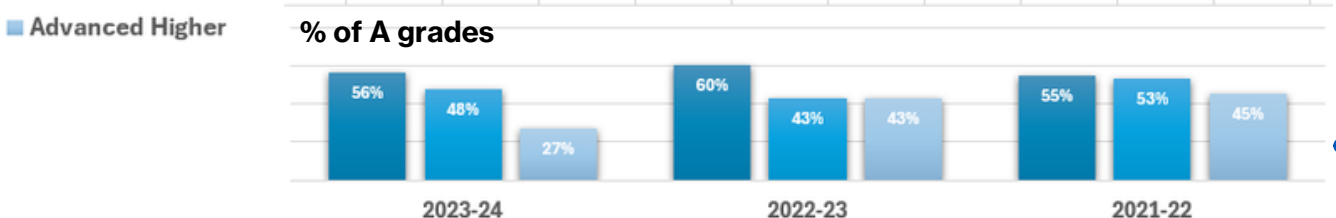
Advanced Higher

LEAVER DESTINATIONS

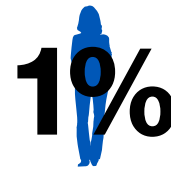

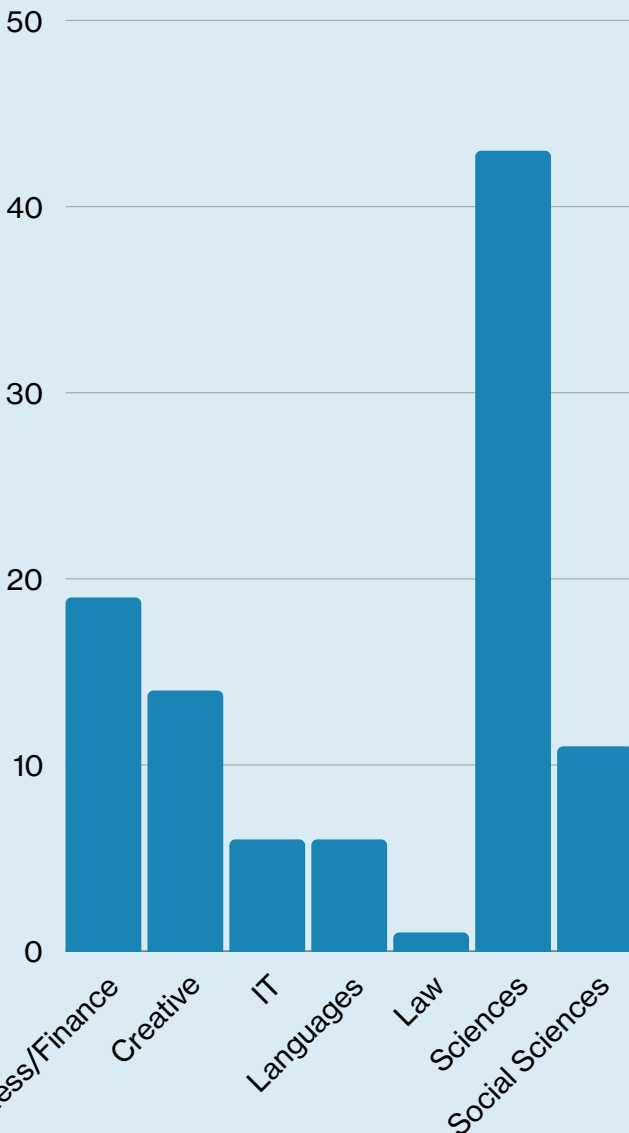
